The Government of Uganda (GoU) received credit and grant from the International Development Association (IDA) towards financing of the Investment for Industrial Transformation and Employment (INVITE) project being implemented by the Private Sector Foundation Uganda (PSFU); Ministry of Finance Planning and Economic Development (MoFPED) and Bank of Uganda (BoU) through the INVITE Trust.
